1. Current negative Coggins required for entry on the show grounds-NO EXCEPTIONS-please send in copy with pre entry
2. All stallions must be handled by an adult-18 & over
3. All riders must sign a "Waiver & Indemnity" Release Form
4. Canterbury Showplace is not responsible for loss or injury to a horse, rider or property
5. Riders under 18, while mounted in Canterbury show grounds must wear an ASTM/SEI approved properly fitted helmet.
6. Relaxed/Casual Attire Show, Shirts must have sleeves and you must wear boots. NO SNEAKERS.
7. Classes may be divided if entries warrant or combined if less than 3 entries
8. Riders are not permitted to cross enter. IE, if you are in a walk/trot division, you may not enter any classes that require a canter, and vice versa, for that show.
9. Rider may change horses at any point during the series.
10. Ties for high point are broken by Showmanship Class.
11. For purposes of this show series, a Green Horse must not have been shown for more than 2 years.
12. There is no entry fee for Class 19, 20 or 21.
13. Management reserves the right to substitute another judge due to unforeseen circumstances.
14. If you scratch a class, you may add a class to replace it. No refunds for scratched class fees will be given, unless approved by management
15. The under saddle divisions will alternate each month beginning in February. IE, in February, the western division under saddle classes will go first, in March the English division under saddle classes will go first, and so on. Under saddle classes will not start before 10:30 am.
16. Management reserves the right to deny any entry, or to request competitors/trainers/owners to leave the property due to bad behavior directed toward any officials, volunteers or staff. Abuse of the horse will not be tolerated.
17. In order to be eligible for High Point, competitors are **REQUIRED** to compete in the Showmanship Class, Equitation or Horsemanship Class, and Pleasure Class for their chosen division. See Below for **REQUIRED classes**.
18. Hi Point and Reserve for each division will be announced and awarded 1 hour after the last class of the day is finished.

Ranch Horse Pleasure Class Rules

Offered as an all age class

1. The purpose of Ranch Horse Pleasure horse should reflect the versatility, attitude, and movement of a working horse
2. The horse's performance should simulate a horse riding outside the confines of an arena and that of a working ranch horse. This class should show the horse's ability to work at a forward, working speed while under control by the rider. Light contact should be rewarded and horse does not have to be shown on a full drape of reins. The overall manners and responsiveness of the horse while performing the maneuver requirements, and the horse's quality of movement are the primary considerations.

Requirements:

- (1) No horses less than 3 years of age.
- (2) Each horse will work individually, performing both required and optional maneuvers, and scored on the basis of 0 to 100, with 70 denoting an average performance.
- (3) The required maneuvers will include the walk, jog, and lope both directions: and the extended jog and lope at least one direction; as well as stops, turn to change directions, and back.
- (4) Three optional maneuvers may include a side pass, turns of 360 or more, change of lead (simple or flying), walk, jog, or lope over a pole(s); or some reasonable combination of maneuvers that would be reasonable for a ranch horse to perform.
- (5) The maneuvers may be arranged in various combinations with final approval by the judge.
- (6) The overall cadence and performance of the gaits should have an emphasis on forward movement, freeflowing, and ground covering for all gaits. Transitions should be performed where designated, with smoothness and responsiveness.
- (7) No time limit.
- (8) Failure to perform a required maneuver will result in a horse placing below all other horses that perform all maneuvers

Apparel and Equipment:

- (1) No hoof polish.
- (2) No braided or banded manes or tail extensions.
- (3) Trimming inside ears is discouraged.
- (4) Trimming bridle path is allowed, also trimming of fetlocks or excessive (long) facial hair.
- (5) Equipment with silver should not count over a good working outfit. Silver on bridles and saddles is discouraged.
